



US-98/SR-158 Extension Projects Safe 98

SR-158 extension from east of Lott Rd. to Schillinger Rd: Crews continued pouring concrete for the bridge over Rodgers Rd and began excavating the westbound roadway west of Seabury Creek. Crews also installed drainage at the southwest corner of Seabury Creek bridge.

SR-158 extension from east of Glenwood Rd. to west of Lott Rd: Placed lower and upper binder asphalt layers at the Stone Rd. intersection and continued grading operations in this area. The Stone Rd. temporary detour was removed, and paving was completed on a portion of the SR-158 extension just west of Stone Rd.

Major Milestones

Other utility, drainage, and construction work not listed here will be performed simultaneously along with these items. The final wearing surface and permanent stripe and markings are added prior to the completion of the project.

- Extend the eastbound bridge over Big Creek **Complete**
- Extend SR-158 from east of Lott Rd. to Schillinger Rd. **In Progress**
- Extend SR-158 from east of Glenwood Rd. to west of Lott Rd. **In Progress**
- Construct the Lott Rd. overpass and jug handle on SR-158
- Construct the bridge on Glenwood Rd. over US-98
- Construct the bridge on Wilmer-Georgetown Rd. over US-98 w/ a jug handle onto US-98
- Extend US-98 from the Mississippi line to 0.5 mile east of Glenwood Rd.
